Body Recovered at Lake Keystone

The Oklahoma Lake Patrol has found the body of a white male in Lake Keystone. Troopers and the Wagoner County Emergency Response Team found the submerged body on the west side of the Lake Keystone Dam, near Gate 2. The recovery was made at 5:10 p.m.

Deputies with the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office dive team, the Oklahoma Lake Patrol, and the Wagoner County Emergency Response Team have been engaged in an extensive search and recovery effort for four days. A man was spotted by four witnesses jumping off of the Keystone Lake Dam on Tuesday afternoon January 29th. A vehicle was left running nearby and a wallet was later found washed up on the shoreline. The identification found inside the wallet belongs to Tulsan Larry Gene Foust, 47 years of age. Authorities ran a registration check on the vehicle and it was determined to be also registered to Foust.

Detectives with the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office and the State of Oklahoma Medical Examiner are continuing their investigation. The body had been transported to the State Medical Examiner's Office in Tulsa for positive identification.
