DEPUTY AND CITIZEN OF THE YEAR NAMED

Sheriff Stanley Glanz is pleased to announce that Sgt. Bob Darby has been named the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Deputy of the Year. Volunteer Chaplain Jose Lozana has been honored as the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Citizen of the Year.

Sgt. Darby is a 26-year veteran of the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office. He is currently the Project Director of the Metro Tulsa Drug Task Force. In this role, he conducts training for other agencies, speaks to the public, coordinates investigations and tracks the statistics of one of the most successful task forces in the State of Oklahoma. Sgt. Darby managed the Tulsa State Fair in 2008 and the 2008 Mike Clancy Toy Drive for 48 needy families and their 123 children. Darby was also recognized for the hundreds of hours of sick leave he has donated to TCSO employees over the years. Sgt. Darby's nomination stated that "...he has a true sense of compassion, consideration, work ethic and moral standard which should be the example of why someone becomes a law enforcement officer."

Jose Lozano is the pastor of the Iglesia De Cristo Church, which he founded 20 years ago. He became a volunteer chaplain for the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office in 2005. Lozano not only provides pastoral care for TCSO employees, but he serves as an on-call field chaplain, ministers to jail inmates, and serves as a translator for both the courts and TCSO detectives. Lozano, who was born in Mexico, became a U.S. citizen in 1991.

These awards were given at the annual Tulsa County Area Law Enforcement Awards, hosted by the Townwest and Southside Sertoma Clubs of Tulsa. This program honors the work of members of the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office, the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Troop B, and the Tulsa Emergency Telecommunications 911 Center.
