Reserve Deputy of the Year Named

Reserve Deputy Robert McKim was named the 2007 Reserve Deputy of the Year at an Awards Ceremony held at 6:00 p.m. at the Faulkner Building on April 8, 2008.

Deputy McKim is a lifelong Tulsa who attended the University of Tulsa. McKim has worked with the Tulsa Police Reserves and the Tulsa County Sheriff's Reserve Program for a combined total in law enforcement of 35 years, volunteering over 30,000 hours. He served in the United States Army as a Command Sergeant and served his county in the South Pacific during WW-2 and the Korean conflict. He was on the command staff that guided five battalions. He was awarded the Bronze Star and fourteen other medals and citations during his tours of duty.

Bob started the security program at Union School District and worked with their security force for over thirty years. He was an engineer with PSO and retired after 36 years. He has enjoyed working many civic events, patrolling the City and County, Tulsa State Fair and working in various areas of the Sheriff's Office.
