INFORMATION SOUGHT FOR RECOVERY OF STOLEN GUNS

MAY 14, 2008

Two guns were stolen from the residence of a Tulsa County Deputy on Sunday, May 11, 2008. The weapons are a Glock .45 caliber handgun and an H&K model assault-type rifle. Ammunition, ammunition magazines for these weapons, a tactical light, a holster and pistol belt, and a gun case were also taken. These items were all located in the locked trunk of the Deputy's vehicle, which was parked in an open garage. The Deputy was at home when the theft occurred. Detectives believe this crime, which took place in the area of 91st Street and Sheridan Avenue, happened between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. The weapons have all been entered into the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) database to facilitate recovery.
