STREET CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS SHERIFF'S OFFICE ACCESS

May 21, 2008

The public parking lot at the main Tulsa County Sheriff's Office building, located at 303 West First Street, will not be accessible for approximately three weeks due to street construction on West First Street. This building is also commonly referred to as the "Dave Faulkner Building."

The facility is utilized by Tulsa County residents for a variety of purposes. Citizens may walk in and make a crime report or meet with detectives. This is where people who are seeking "conceal/carry permits" complete their application packets with fingerprinting and records checks. Criminal background checks are also conducted and picked up here. Sex Offenders residing in Tulsa County must register at this facility. County dog licenses and breeder permits are also obtained at this location.

Citizens who need to conduct business at the Sheriff's Office are requested to access the Faulkner Building from Elwood Avenue, either from West First Street or Archer Street. Parking for the public will be located on Elwood Avenue, and there will be directional signs. For additional help locating the Elwood Avenue entrance, citizens may call 596-5701.
