TULSA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE HOSTS SWAT CHAMPIONSHIP

Sheriff Stanley Glanz is pleased to announce the 2009 US National SWAT Championships (USNSC) is being hosted by the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office. This prestigious competition will take place at the U.S. Shooting Academy, located at 6500 E. 66th Street North, Thursday, June 18th through Saturday June 20th. Teams from law enforcement agencies across the United States and Europe will be in Tulsa to demonstrate their superior tactical and weapons skills.

The competition, which is open to the public for viewing, will take place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The championship will culminate with an awards ceremony at the Renaissance Hotel on Saturday, June 20th at 7:00 p.m.

The US National SWAT Championships are open to any law enforcement agency's SWAT or tactical team. This elite competition consists of events in which teams compete in full tactical gear and they are tested for weapons proficiency, physical fitness, team organization and stamina. In addition to the competition, officers are provided the opportunity to participate in tactical training from top experts and the opportunity to see the most advanced technology available from vendors.
