## **Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Announces the Creation of a Full-time Public Information Officer November 6, 2009**

Sheriff Stanley Glanz announced today the creation of a full-time Public Information Officer. This position will afford the local, state and national media, along with community interest groups, a point of contact when inquiring about any and all aspects of the Sheriff's Office.

Sgt Clark has served as the Public Information Officer for the Detention Division for the last four years. In addition to his role as PIO, Sgt. Clark will also coordinate a social networking feature for the Sheriff's Office – slated to comprise approximately 50% of his duties. Sgt. Clark has also been very active with media events that have covered the state's only 287(g) Immigration Enforcement Program.

Sgt. Clark is a seventeen year law enforcement veteran, having served in all three divisions of the Sheriff's Office. He has spent his last 4½ years as the Administrative Sergeant for the David L. Moss Criminal Justice Center. Prior to being assigned to the Detention Division in 2005, when the operation of the jail was returned to Sheriff Glanz, Sgt. Clark spent time in patrol as a field training officer, the fugitive extraditions unit, court operations and investigations.

Along with his new assignment, Sgt. Clark will continue to oversee and supervise the partnership between the Department of Homeland Security and the TCSO 287(g) Immigration Enforcement Program. Sgt. Clark is a graduate of the National Immigrations Enforcement Academy, commissioning him with federal immigration and customs authority.

Sergeant Clark holds an advanced certification through the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) along with receiving numerous local and state awards. He most recently received the Recognition Award through the Oklahoma Sheriff's Association at the 2009 annual banquet. He is a graduate of Leadership Tulsa (class 39), graduate of the Institute for Law Enforcement Administration, Center for American and International Law, School of Police Supervision a member of Tulsa's Young Professional and numerous other community advisory boards.
